- Early Tsunami Detection (i.e. deepwater observation, real-time simulation)
- Tsunami Nearshore Transformation and Flooding on Land
- Seismic Liquefaction and Tsunami Action on Structures
- Post-Event Problem (i.e. tidal flooding owing to seismic land subsidence, floating debris)
- Potential Highest Tsunami and Optimum Hard-Measure Level for Future Tsunamis
- Resilient Coastal Defense (i.e. scouring on structure from tsunami overtopping)
- Plantation/Coastal Forest as Tsunami Mitigation Measure
- Scouring and Other Geotechnical Issues Caused by Tsunami
- Experimental and Numerical Methods on Tsunami, Tsunami Pressure or Long Waves
- Modeling and Experiments for Landslide Tsunami Generation and Tsunami Sources in Propagation

All papers accepted upon peer-review will be published in ISOPE conference proceedings indexed by Engineering Index (EI), Scopus, Web of Science and more. High-quality papers may be selected for further review for publication on *The International Journal of Offshore and Polar Engineering*, indexed by Science Citation Index- E.
